Candidates who are selected to be on the ballot will be contacted and asked to provide electronic copies of their letter of intent and resume as well as a photo and candidate message to be posted on the Board Elections website.

## e-Voting Update

Once again, we’ll again be offering an e-voting option, in keeping with the spirit that cooperative owner activities need to be part of the online world. Owners can choose to cast their votes via the Simply Voting (simplyvoting.com) tool.
