CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Scott McFarland, Honor Credit Union, St. Joseph, MI, called the meeting to order. He

MINUTES

Action Item: A motion by Kris Lewis, Allegan Community Credit Union, and supported by Barbara Page, Kent County Credit Union, was made to accept the minutes of the June 27, 2018, Annual Meeting. Motion passed.

CHAIRMAN'S COMMENTS

- Chairman Scott McFarland's message this year was "What will we take to the future."
 - o The Chairman's welcomed the 3 new owners.
 - o Discussion followed on the approaching 50-year anniversary of CU*Answers in 2020.
 - Chairman McFarland discussed the theme "We are Evolving Pioneers."
- The Board of Directors were recognized for their dedicated work. Linda Bodie, Tom Gryp, Kris Lewis, Jeff Jorgensen, Dean Wilson, Vickie Schmitzer and Scott McFarland.

ELECTION OF BOARD

Regular Election

The nominating committee this year included Tom Gryp (Chair), Notre Dame FCU, Scott McFarland, Honor CU, Dean Wilson, FOCUS CU.

There are 136 Class A shareholders entitled to vote at this meeting. A notice of the meeting, proxy statement, and form of proxy were mailed/emailed to all shareholders on May 1, 2019.

Tom Gryp, Nominating Committee Chair, announced there were two director positions available, and two candidates running for election. The two candidates running for election are Linda Bodie, Element FCU, and Jeff Jorgensen, Sioux Empire FCU for a 3-year term to begin October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022.

The candidates were introduced, and each said a few words.

Action Item: A motion by Mark Richter, First United CU, and supported by Janelle Franke, River Valley CU, was made to cast a unanimous consent to elect the candidates. Motion passed.

The candidates were elected unanimously.

Tom Gryp announced the introduction of 2 Associate Board Members: Carolyn Mikesell, Public Service CU and Bill Burke, Day Air CU. Don Mills will be serving on the investment committee.



FINANCIAL STATEMENT

- Bob Frizzle reviewed the Financial Statement and presented "A Model for the Future." For those

- Bob highlighted the following:
 - o Importance of new owners for the future.
 - o Net Income & Patronage Dividends were discussed.
 - o 2018 numbers worth celebrating were discussed.
 - Year-end 2018 dividend payments these numbers can flex, and Bob predicts they will change in the future.
 - o 2018 return on investment was \$7,060,522.
 - Understanding the formula is important to how we set the boundaries for our future, and Bob discussed the 2018 return per total dollars received.
 - o Discussion on the projected revenues for 2019-year end.
 - o Bob discussed the importance of the firm's per-share price.
